- If there is still no progress at the end of the year, we will have another townhall meeting and vote for the organization for donation of our earthquake funds.
In this case we will donate all the amount to Nepal Rebuilding Authority or any other suitable organizations townhall decides.
- Committee will do a feasibility and transparency study by reaching out with NRN to work in collaboration with them which is the first phase of the project.
- Committee will have four weeks time for the deadline of this first phase.
- We have selected Himalayan Ma Vi for the target project for building school. If there is roadblock on this project committee can pick another similar project.
- Donors will be updated after the completion of project only.
- Committee shall get the project timeline and progress and updates from the consumer committee (Upabhokta Samiti)
- Committee will ensure that we have the impact of our relief efforts and also get recognition for it.
